From Gardiner westbound: take Spadina off ramp and keep right for Lakeshore Blvd. to Fort York Blvd.

Public Transit Directions: Take the 511 streetcar south from Bathurst subway station. There is a foot bridge connecting Bathurst Street to the forts eastern gate.

Parking: Free parking available from Garrison Road.
